Middle School Group—Mondays, 6:30-8:00pm


High School Group—Tuesdays, 6:30-8:00pm


Wednesday Bible Study Begins September 6—See You There!!

In God's Image

In the first chapter of Genesis, we learn of God's creation. God's breath—God's spirit—hovered over lifeless waters as an eagle flutters over her young. God spoke and brought order out of chaos, created swarms of abundant life, and commanded them to be fruitful and multiply. Upon creating humans in God's image, God commanded them to subdue the earth and have dominion over all life, and they were to do these things by reflecting the image into which they had been created. They were to bring order, make abundant life and growth possible, and to be fruitful and multiply. In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus gave his disciples a similar command: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." Jesus commanded his disciples to care for the powerless, to heal the sick, to feed the hungry, and to fight evil. We are commanded to do the same. Bethany Christian Church unites believers to fulfill this calling. Because of God's abundance, we know there is and will be more than enough. Because Jesus is with us, we can thank God for the good work God will do through us. Because we are filled with the Spirit, we have the power to bear fruit that brings life and the God of life to the world—fruit that multiplies. Bethany is in the process of discerning God's specific call for us, and in September we are inviting members of the community to reflect on the resources they have and discern what they will devote to the work God will do through us. On September 24, we make those commitments and celebrate the ministry and service they will make possible. I thank God for you, your faith, and your generosity.

Reflecting on "the Box"

I am a relatively new member of Bethany Christian Church, having transferred my membership only a couple of years ago. I love my new church home and family. Thank you for being so welcoming and kind. I have been thinking and praying A LOT about Bethany's future since I arrived. When I heard about the Suggestion Box, I had *all kinds* of ideas. I think that how we approach the "box" is at least as important as the suggestions we put into it, maybe more so. In my past, I've seen people put in suggestions to further their personal agendas; promote evangelism practices from 30, 40, or 50 years ago; and/or suggest wonderful ideas without intending to do the work necessary to accomplish them. People of the Bethany Christian community must do something very different.

We need to do some internal work before we approach the "box". Pray. Study scripture. Write out our suggestions—and then, before we submit them, go back and *edit* them! We need to go through the process of thinking, feeling, and praying our way through the implications of the visions that we may be receiving from God. The Suggestion Box is part of a larger process. We, as the Bethany family, in and through Jesus Christ, will be discerning these visions *together*. The Strategic Planning Committee will be prayerfully reading and reviewing these suggestions and visions. There will be a discernment process laid out, and we will *all* need to participate if we are to have any chance of discovering and following the vision that God is laying out for us at Bethany Christian Church.

Finally, I would recommend being open to the radical—and often shocking!—visions that God might be calling you to put into the Suggestion Box. When Jesus taught about the Kindom of God, he answered in parables that always had astonishing twists that made people completely re-assess what they thought they knew about God and God's Realm on Earth. Mustard seeds, persistent wid-ows, lost sheep, prodigal sons (and their fathers!), buried treasure, alert virgins, and even a fraudu-lent manager are all likened to God's Kindom. If an idea pops into your mind, but it just seems too weird, don't dismiss it! Follow it. Pray more about it. Think through the shocking implications of it. That just might be the parable that Bethany Christian Church needs to perceive the astonishing new thing that God has for us.
